**Frequently Asked Questions**

Q: What are the dates of the 2026 Wyoming Republican Convention?

A: Convention pages must arrive in Cheyenne WY and be present for orientation by 5:00 PM on Thursday, April 23rd, 2026, and are expected to be on call through Convention adjournment on Saturday, April 25th, 2026.

Q: What do page duties include?

A: Duties will include assisting with Convention Committee meetings acting as floor runners, and distributing official convention materials during sessions. There are many activities being planned, and duties will differ each day.

Q: How does one become a page at the 2026 Wyoming Republican Convention?

A: Pages must be nominated by at least two Wyoming Republican (WYGOP) party members from their county or district. Nomination forms should be returned to Kathy Russell, WYGOP Executive Director, by 5:00 PM March 31, 2026.

Q: What are the qualifications to be a Page.

A: Pages must be 16 to 22 years old, although it is strongly encouraged participants be between 18 and 22 years old.

Q: How many pages can each Wyoming Republican District nominate?

A: Each WYGOP District may submit **two** nominations.

The seven Districts in the Wyoming Republican Party are:

DISTRICT 1	Albany, Laramie, Platte
DISTRICT 2	Sweetwater, Uinta, Carbon
DISTRICT 3	Lincoln, Sublette, Teton
DISTRICT 4	Fremont, Natrona, Converse
DISTRICT 5	Big Horn, Hot Springs, Park, Washakie
DISTRICT 6	Campbell, Johnson, Sheridan
DISTRICT 7	Crook, Weston, Niobrara, Goshen

Q: What are the costs associated with being a page?

A: Pages are responsible for the cost of their own transportation to and from Douglas. Pages are also responsible for meals or snacks other than those provided at Convention sponsored events, and other incidental costs.

Q: What are the accommodations for pages?

A: The WYGOP is planning to cover housing costs for the Pages. Pages will be housed at a nearby hotel or dorm and will be assigned a roommate of the same gender. Every effort will be made to honor specific roommate requests.

Q: Can you summarize the program's basic daily activities?

A: There will be a full schedule of activities for Pages. There will be briefings every morning at 8:00 AM in the Convention state office.

Q: What is the attire for Pages on duty?

A: White top and black slacks, jeans or skirt. Comfortable footwear is suggested.

Q: When will the Page selections be announced?

A: The Pages selected to serve will be announced on or before April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
