1. Call to Order

CCRP Chairman Heather Herr called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Chairman Herr thanked everyone for attending.

2. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance – Justin Mader gave the invocation and lead the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance.

6. Officer Reports

Chairman's Report

Chairman Herr said the fundraising efforts are well underway and would be reported on later in the meeting. She thanked all the people who volunteered to work at the Campbell County Fair booth. The CCRP Executive Committee voted to appoint Sasha Davidson to fill the vacancy in precinct 1-26 and Gail Lofing to fill the vacancy in precinct 1-25.

Vice Chairman's Report

Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Bell reported that the CCRP Executive Committee approved the budget for the 2021-2022 fiscal year. \$10,509.24 is the amount required to pay operating expenses. County dues are approximately \$8,200 and it our goal to allocate \$20,000 to Republicans running for office in 2022.

State Committeeman's Report

Chairman Herr attended the Wyoming State Central Committee meeting in Evanston, Wyoming on July 10, 2021. Doug and Charlene attended as proxy carriers for Tom Lubnau and Heidi Gross. Regular business was conducted and a discussion was held on counties that had not paid their state dues. The State Executive Committee decided to give a 90 day grace period to the 4 counties who have not paid their state dues as yet. The next State meeting will be Nov 12-13 in Sheridan.

Fund raising Committee Report

Ronda Boller reported that the Ice Cream Social fundraising committee has sold 112 tickets, with 14 tables being sold. Their goal was to sell 96 tickets so they have already surpassed that. The event will begin at 4 pm, there will be an open cash bar catered by Prime Rib, a few silent auction items and a pie auction. Red Steagall is the featured guest speaker and will share a pie with the winning bidder. Kellen Smith will provide music and there will be a VIP reception for Red Steagall after the Ice Cream social.

Marketing Committee Report

Darla Cotton was unable to attend but sent word that she is working on the Pay Pal account and the chain of custody concerns. The password has been reset and things are starting to move forward with the website.

- a. Social Media Policy review. Chairman Herr reported that she spent considerable time revising the policy that was originally presented.
