

BYLAW AMENDMENT #1- CCRP

Article III County Central Committee

1. Membership

1. The County Central Committee shall consist of the properly elected or appointed Republican Precinct Committeemen and Committeewomen who shall hold office for a term of two (2) years or until their successors have been properly elected or appointed. Each precinct shall elect one
 - (1) Committeeman and one (1) Committeewoman for each two hundred fifty (250) votes or major fraction thereof cast for the Republican candidate for United States Representative in the last general election, but provided no precinct shall be entitled to less than one (1) Precinct Committeeman and one (1) Precinct Committeewoman.
2. Precinct Committeemen and Committeewomen shall be electors registered in the Republican Party and shall reside in the precinct as defined by W.S. § 22-1-102(a)(xxx).

BYLAW AMENDMENT #2- CCRP (Related to Amendment #2)

Article III County Central Committee

1. Membership

1. The County Central Committee shall consist of the properly elected or appointed Republican Precinct Committeemen and Committeewomen who shall hold office for a term of two (2) years or until their successors have been properly elected or appointed. Each precinct shall elect one
 - (1) Committeeman and one (1) Committeewoman for each two hundred fifty (250) votes or major fraction thereof cast for the Republican candidate for United States Representative in the last general election, but provided no precinct shall be entitled to less than one (1) Precinct Committeeman and one (1) Precinct Committeewoman.
2. Precinct Committeemen and Committeewomen shall be electors registered in the Republican Party and shall reside in the precinct. **Residence is defined as their registered voting address.**

BYLAW AMENDMENT #3- CCRP

Article III County Central Committee

2. Meetings

1. The County Central Committee shall meet as follows:
2. ~~Within thirty (30) days after the County Party Chairman has received notice from the County Clerk that all of the County Central Committee members have been certified elected, for the purpose of organization. The meeting shall be held at the time and place determined by the County Party Chairman.~~ The county central committee shall meet and organize under the direction of the county chairman at the time and place determined by the county chairman within thirty (30) days after the term of its members begins. The county chairman shall also publish a notice of all meetings of the county central committee in a newspaper of general county circulation not less than two (2) days prior to a meeting.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #4- CCRP

Article III County Central Committee

3. Powers

1. The County Central Committee shall exercise those powers conferred upon it by law, and these County Bylaws. The County Central Committee is empowered to determine policy, to make rules, to settle disputes, and to perform all functions necessary to promote the Mission of the Campbell County Republican Party and to further the interests of the Wyoming Republican Party.
2. The County Central Committee will have the ability to draft and adopt resolutions that are not intended to be presented at the County or State Convention. All resolutions intended to be adopted at the County or State Conventions will be enacted using Article IV of these Bylaws. Any resolution adopted outside of the County Convention process shall receive a majority vote of the Central Committee and no resolution will remain in affect beyond the current term of the County Central Committee.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #5- CCRP

Article III County Central Committee

4. Quorum

1. ~~Those members of the County Central Committee attending either in person or by proxy, a properly called meeting of the County Central Committee shall constitute a quorum and be entitled to vote on the issues before the meeting.~~ A majority of the county Central Committee shall constitute a quorum. Members entitled to vote on the issues before the County Central Committee meeting shall include those attending either in person or by proxy.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #6- CCRP

Article III County Central Committee

6. Officers and Terms of Office

1. The County Chairman, Vice Chairman, State Committeeman and State Committeewoman shall be elected by the County Central Committee at its March meeting in the odd numbered years to serve for a term of two (2) years. The County Party shall immediately notify the State Chairman in writing of the names and addresses of persons elected to the offices of County Chairman, State Committeeman and State Committeewoman.
2. The County Secretary, County Treasurer, other Central Committee chairmanships and positions created by the County Central Committee shall be appointed. The appointments of the County Secretary and County Treasurer shall take place within thirty (30) days after election of the County Chairman.
3. ~~None of the foregoing officers, committee chairmen or committee members need be members of the County Central Committee but each must be registered in the Republican Party and a resident of Campbell County.~~ All Officers of the County Executive Committee, to include the County Chairman, Vice Chairman, State Committeeman, State Committeewoman and other positions determined to be in the Executive Committee, shall be an elected Precinct Committeeman or Precinct Committeewoman of the County Central Committee. Non-executive Committee members need not be County Central Committee members but must be registered Republicans and residents of Campbell County, Wyoming.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #7- CCRP (Related to Amendment #6)

Article III County Central Committee

6. Officers and Terms of Office

3. ~~None of~~ The foregoing officers, committee chairmen or committee members shall be members of the County Central Committee and shall be elected by the voters of their respective county precinct. but each must be registered in the Republican Party and a resident of Campbell County.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #8- CCRP

Article III County Central Committee

8. County Committees

1. The County Central Committee may select a County Executive Committee and other committees and sub-committees as it from time to time may determine as proper, and it may delegate any of its powers to such a committee or subcommittee.
2. The County Executive Committee shall consist of the elected and appointed officers of the Central Committee. All elected and appointed officers of the Central Committee shall be voting members. The County Executive Committee may also include up to eight (8) At-Large Members appointed by the County Executive Committee. At-Large Members shall be non- voting members. County Executive Committee Members may attend meetings by telephone or video conferencing. County Executive Committee Members cannot, however, participate by e- mail.
3. The County Executive Committee shall have, but not be limited to, the following powers:
 - (a) To fill vacancies in the office of Precinct Committeeman and Precinct Committeewoman and delegates or alternates to the Republican National Convention, unless otherwise provided by these Bylaws.
 - (b) ~~To ratify emergency actions taken by the County Chairman.~~
 - (c) To conduct business on behalf of the Central Committee. The County Chairman will call a meeting of the Executive Committee to determine any action taken.
 - (d) To ~~further the interests~~ promote the platforms and planks of the Wyoming Republican Party.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #9- CCRP

Article III County Central Committee

9. Voting

1. Only properly elected, selected or appointed Precinct Committeemen and Precinct Committeewomen shall be entitled to vote at County Central Committee meetings.
2. ~~In the event the County Chairman is also a Precinct Committeeman or Precinct Committeewoman, he shall be entitled to vote his vote as a Precinct Committeeman or Precinct Committeewoman.~~

BYLAW AMENDMENT #10- CCRP

Article III County Central Committee

12. Attendance

1. Central Committee Members - Any duly elected Central Committee person should attend, in person, at least two regularly scheduled Central Committee meetings per year. The Executive Committee will review the attendance list at the end of the year. Members failing to meet this requirement shall be asked to forfeit their seat so a replacement can be appointed by the Executive Committee.

2. State Central Committee Members – Any duly elected Republican State Central Committee Person shall attend at least fifty (50) percent of all regularly scheduled State Central Committee meetings and at least fifty (50) percent of all regularly scheduled County Central Committee meetings. If said Committee person misses at least fifty (50) percent of the State meetings or fifty (50) percent of the County meetings, they shall forfeit their position. The County Central Committee shall then elect a new State Committee Person.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #11- CCRP

Article IV County Convention

I. Membership

1. Delegates to the County Convention shall be the members of the County Central Committee and those chosen by the caucuses of the several precincts within Campbell County. All County Convention Delegates and Alternates shall be at the time of the call for the Convention be residents of the precinct they represent and registered Republicans.
- ~~2. If the prescribed number of Delegates is not duly elected by Precinct Caucuses in certain precinct(s), the County Chairman with approval of the majority of the County Executive Committee is authorized to appoint the prescribed number of Delegates from the precinct(s) to the County Convention.~~

BYLAW AMENDMENT #12- CCRP

Article IV County Convention

2. Precinct Caucus

1. Precinct Caucuses shall be held not more than twenty five (25) days nor less than ten (10) days prior to the County Convention or as provided by these County Bylaws.
2. The County Chairman shall issue the call for the Precinct Caucuses by publishing a notice of the number of Delegates to be selected from each precinct, the date, time, and place for each caucus in a newspaper(s) of general circulation in Campbell County not less than ten (10) days prior to the Precinct Caucuses.
3. Several Precinct Caucuses may be held in a single location. In any year that it is practicable, the County Party shall hold an All-Precinct Caucus at a central location in Campbell County. All Republicans who have registered within the precinct at the dates of the call of the Precinct Caucus shall be entitled to participate and vote at the Precinct Caucus.
4. Proof of such residence and registration shall be by the County Clerk's voter list as of the date of the call of the Precinct Caucus.
5. Proxy votes will not be allowed at the precinct caucuses.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #13- WYRP

Article III County Central Committees

4. Quorum

~~a. Those members of the County Central Committee attending either in person or by proxy, a properly called meeting of the County Central Committee shall constitute a quorum and be entitled to vote on the issues before the meeting.~~ A majority of the county Central Committee shall constitute a quorum. Members entitled to vote on the issues before the County Central Committee meeting shall include those attending either in person or by proxy.

BYLAW AMENDMENT #14- WYRP

Article V State Central Committee

1. Membership

1. The Republican State Central Committee shall consist of the properly elected State Committeeman, State Committeewoman, and County Chairman of each county.
2. The National Committeeman, National Committeewoman, State Chairman, State Vice Chairman and State Secretary shall also be members of the State Central Committee.
3. Members of the State Central Committee shall serve and be entitled to vote at all properly called State Central Committee meetings for a term of two (2) years or until their successors are properly elected or appointed.
4. In any event, no member of the State Central Committee shall be able to exercise more than one vote.
- ~~5. Members of the State Central Committee, upon election or appointment to their respected position granting them membership to the Wyoming Republican Party State Central Committee, shall sign a statement of nondisclosure outlining the definition of confidentiality and binding any member to adhere to stated definition for instances such as executive session, disciplinary proceedings, political plan briefings, presidential campaign representative visits, election related budgetary discussions, or any item deemed 'Confidential' by the State Chairman and ratified by the State Central Committee or by majority vote of the State Central Committee.~~

BYLAW AMENDMENT #15- WYRP

Article V State Central Committee

7.State Party Officer Vacancies

1. A vacancy in a State Central Committee office shall occur in case of death, resignation,removal of residence from the state, inability to act, as determined by the State Central Committee,~~or failure to elect at a regularly scheduled election.~~

BYLAW AMENDMENT #16- WYRP

Article V State Central Committee

8. Officers

1. Officers of the State Central Committee shall consist of a State Chairman, State Vice Chairman, and Secretary, elected by the State Central Committee and a Treasurer, appointed by the State Chairman.
2. The State Chairman shall appoint as many committee chairmen and committee members as he deems in the best interest of the Party.
3. ~~None of~~ The foregoing officers, committee chairmen or committee members ~~need~~ shall be members of the State Central Committee, ~~but~~ and shall be elected by the voters of their respective county precinct and shall be properly elected by the members of their respective county central committee ~~each must be registered in the Party and a resident of the State.~~

BYLAW AMENDMENT #17- WYRP

Article V State Central Committee

8. Officers

1. Officers of the State Central Committee shall consist of a State Chairman, State Vice Chairman, and Secretary, elected by the State Central Committee and a Treasurer, appointed by the State Chairman.
2. The State Chairman shall appoint as many committee chairmen and committee members as he deems in the best interest of the Party.
3. None of the foregoing officers, committee chairmen or committee members need be members of the State Central Committee, but each must be registered in the Party and a resident of the State.
4. The Vice Chairman shall become the Chairman in the event of a vacancy in the Chairman position.
5. A vacancy in the Vice Chairman or Secretary position shall be filled by election held by the State Central Committee within one hundred twenty (120) days after the effective date of the vacancy.
6. Conflict of Interest
 - (a) No member of the State Executive Committee, elected or appointed, may employ any immediate family member without the approval of the State Central Committee.
 - i. "Employ" means the placement of a family member into the State Republican party structure in any capacity by appointment, employment or by contract.
 - ii. "Immediate Family Member" includes any direct family relationship such as but not limited to: spouse, parent-child, grandparent-grandchild, brother or sister.
 - iii. The consideration of an "immediate family member" for appointment, employment or contract services must be approved by the State Central Committee by secret ballot with two thirds of the State Central Committee quorum.
 - (b) No immediate family member of a State Executive Committee member may be elected to, appointed to or employed by the State Republican Party. ~~Structure without the approval of the State Central Committee.~~ In the event a family member of a State Executive Committee member is to be employed by the State Republican Party, the State Central Committee must approve such ~~an appointment, election or~~ employment by secret ballot with two thirds of the State Central Committee quorum.
