Central Committee Meeting Minutes

February 13, 2020

Campbell County Public Library, Gillette, WY

A. Call to Order

- The regular meeting of the Campbell County Republican Party was held on Thursday, February 13, 2020, at 6:00 P.M., in the Wyoming Room of the Campbell County Public Library, the Chairman being in the chair and the Secretary being present.

B. Opening Ceremonies

Pink Elephant Ball and 2020 State Convention Report given by Chairman Kissack – PEB Event scheduled for May 7th, speaker is Beth Ann, Common Sense Radio Talk Show host, posters are available – Ed Rebich and Jarik Dudley are co-chairs. Need volunteers for State Convention.

Precinct Caucus (March 7th) - County Convention (March 28th) Report - given by Secretary Barb Luthy and Chairman Vicki Kissack. Information regarding caucus and convention agendas and expectations is included in “red” folder. Resolutions, Platforms and Bylaws amendments should all be brought forward from the Precinct Caucus to County Convention.
