REPUBLICANS OF CAMPBELL COUNTY CONTRACT RESOLUTION

Whereas the constituents of Campbell County have voiced their desire to send elected officials to the Wyoming Senate and House of Representatives who are committed to advancing the Republican Party planks and values, and

Whereas Campbell County constituents have expressed they have a low level of trust that their elected officials will represent their desires and concerns, and

Whereas the Republicans of Campbell County Contract was written to restore the bonds of trust between the people of Campbell County and their elected officials, and

Whereas Campbell County is represented in the Wyoming Legislature by three (3) senators and five (5) representatives, and

Whereas current Representative and Republican primary election winner Roy Edwards HD 53, and the Republican Primary Election winners John Bear HD 31, Bill Fortner HD 52, and Troy McKeown SD 24 have chosen to sign the Republicans of Campbell County Contract and requested Campbell County constituents to hold them accountable,

Be it resolved that the Campbell County Republican Party endorses the Republicans of Campbell County Contract and the four (4) signers to uphold and advance Republican Party Platform principles and values.

A Resolution for Freedom of Speech

(approved and submitted by Campbell County)

WHEREAS the Wyoming Republican Party's Platform includes the following:

20. Freedom of speech is a fundamental right secured by the United States Constitution and the Constitution of the State of Wyoming. Freedom of speech includes the freedom of the individual to express his or her beliefs, ideas and opinions without fear of retaliation, censorship or legal sanction by government.

WHEREAS, freedom to engage in association for the advancement of beliefs and ideas is an inseparable aspect of the 'liberty' assured by the Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment, which embraces freedom of speech....it is immaterial whether the beliefs sought to be advanced by association pertain to political, economic, religious or cultural matters" any action which may have the effect of curtailing the freedom to associate is subject to the closest scrutiny.' NAACP v. Alabama ex rel. Patterson, 357 U.S. 449, 460-61.

WHEREAS we would still be a British Colony if our founders had not associated with diverse groups to discuss and act on problems. WHEREAS the Wyoming Republican State Party censured the Natrona County State Committeewoman for her involvement in the Cowgirl Run Fund, a nonpartisan political action committee that supports women running for state and local office in Wyoming, whose mission is to help elect more women so that women's voices are present in shaping public policy.

WHEREAS, the concepts of freedom of speech and encouraging more women to be involved in politics should be supported by every County Republican Party and the State Republican Party. AND WHEREAS, action to punish and discipline members of the State Republican Party for personally encouraging more women to be engaged in politics should be condemned, as it is inconsistent with our U.S. and Wyoming Constitutions, our Party Platform, and, simply, wrong.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Campbell County Republican Party fully embraces our constitutional rights of freedom of speech and freedom to associate with anyone we may choose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Campbell County Republican Party encourages women, along with all others, to engage in the Wyoming political system.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Campbell County Republican Party condemns the State Republican Party's censure of the Natrona County State Committeewoman and calls on each County Republican Party and the State Republican Party to do the same.
